## YTD FIGURES RELATE TO **1ST JUNE 2023 TO 31ST MAY 2024**

The income to support the activities outlined in our business plan is derived principally from the levy collected from within businesses boundary, although some income will arise from external sources such as sponsorship. grants and voluntary memberships.

As owners/tenants liable for defined, business-rated premises inside the BID boundary, you are required by law to pay an annual contribution towards the identified costs of operating the BID company.

This levy is based on the rateable value of the property you occupy or own, as stated on the ratings list held by the Council's rating department as at 1st April 2023. This is the Rating Valuation (RV) that has been applied to create your invoice.

All rated and liable business properties within the BID boundary will pay 1.65% of their assigned RV. Vacant units will also be charged the same with the bill met by the individual(s) or organisation liable for the property, which may be the landlord/managing agent. Any state school within the BID boundary will receive a 90% discount.

The BID operates on a not-for-profit basis, meaning that all income from BID levy and other sources is used towards improvement projects and approved overheads as specified in the mandated Ilkley BID Business Plan for 2024-29.

This bill, and future bills, can be paid in instalments by arrangement. Please telephone the Business Rates department at Bradford Council who collect the money on our behalf to set this up.
